3. Why is the question, "who do you say that I am?", such an audacious one?
4. What was Peter's misunderstanding of Jesus? Why do you think it was so hard for Peter to accept a suffering Messiah?
5. What is the difference between a creedal response to this greatest question, and one that is answered with our life?
6. What would it mean to answer Jesus' question with our life?
7. According Bono, what got Jesus killed?
8. What convinces you that Jesus was who he says He was?
